## TraumaBased Screenings and Assessments - BHARP

A trauma assessment can determine strengths as well as clinical symptoms of traumatic stress. It assesses the severity of symptoms, and can determine the impact of trauma (how thoughts, emotions, and behaviors have been changed by trauma) on the child's functioning in the various wellbeing domains.
